



PRIVACY NOTICE

Information notice to the Data Subject pursuant to and for the purposes of Art. 13 of EU Regulation 2016/679 (“GDPR”), concerning the processing of personal data.

Pursuant to the above-mentioned GDPR, A.S.D. Arabesque di Cristina Chirco, organizer of the Cuneo Dance Meeting event, as Data Controller and Processor, will process personal, identifying and personal data with the methods and precautions indicated below.

Purpose of processing and legal basis

The Association processes your personal data exclusively for the performance of its institutional activity:

- a) for the management of the request to participate in the activities proposed by the Association, in particular within the Cuneo Dance Meeting event;
- b) for participation in courses, meetings, events and for the organization and management of dance classes;
- c) to comply with legal obligations (e.g. fiscal, insurance, etc.) relating to participants in the Cuneo Dance Meeting event;
- d) to comply with the provisions of sports regulations;
- e) for sending communications related to the Association’s activities and initiatives;
- f) in relation to images/videos, for publication on the Association’s website, on the Association’s social networks or in newsletters or printed promotional material relating to the Association’s institutional activities;
- g) for statistical analysis, also in aggregated form, and verification of the level of satisfaction of participants regarding the services offered.

The legal basis for processing is represented by the request for participation (Art. 6, paragraph 1, letter b, GDPR), consent to processing (Art. 6, paragraph 1, letter a – Art. 9, paragraph 2, letter a, GDPR), and legal obligations to which the Association is subject (Art. 6, paragraph 1, letter c, GDPR).

Processing methods and principles

The collection and processing of data will take place only after the consent of the data subject or, in the case of minor participants, of those exercising parental responsibility or their legal guardians.

Processing will be carried out in compliance with the GDPR and Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 (“Personal Data Protection Code”), as well as the principles of lawfulness, fairness and transparency, adequacy and relevance, using paper and electronic means, by persons authorized by the Association and with the adoption of appropriate protection measures, in order to guarantee the security and confidentiality of the data.

Necessity of data provision

The provision of personal and contact data is necessary as it is strictly connected to the management of the associative relationship. Consent to the use of images/videos and their publication on the institutional website and in the other ways described above is optional.

Data communication and transfer abroad

Data may be communicated to other members for the purposes of organizing and carrying out the service. Data may be communicated to parties responsible for carrying out activities to which the Association is subject by law (accountant, insurer, IT technician, affiliated entities, etc.) and to all natural and/or legal persons, public and/or private, when communication is necessary or functional to the performance of the institutional activity (trainers, local authorities, IT maintenance companies, etc.).

Data may be transferred to recipients located outside the EU who have signed agreements ensuring an adequate level of protection of personal data, or after verification that the recipient guarantees adequate protection measures.

Where necessary or appropriate, the subjects to whom data are transmitted for activities on behalf of the Association will be appointed as (external) Data Processors pursuant to Art. 28 GDPR.

Data retention period

The data will be used by the Association until the termination of the associative relationship. After that date, they will be stored for archiving purposes, legal, accounting or fiscal obligations, or for the protection needs of the Association, excluding communication to third parties and dissemination, always applying the principles of proportionality and minimization.

Rights of the data subject

As a data subject, all rights specified in Articles 15–20 of the GDPR are guaranteed, including the right of access, rectification and erasure of data, the right to restriction and/or objection to processing, the right to withdraw consent (without affecting the lawfulness of processing based on consent before withdrawal), as well as the right to lodge a complaint with the Data Protection Authority if the processing is deemed to violate the GDPR or Italian law.

These rights may be exercised by sending a communication via email, certified email (PEC), or registered mail to the Association's headquarters.
